The North Country Chamber Players' mission is to culturally enrich the communities of northern New Hampshire through high-quality performances of the chamber music repertoire and through creative, interactive educational and community programs.

During the course of more than 32 years of performances, the Players have endeared themselves to residents and visitors of the White Mountains. They have mentored and tutored a generation of youthful players, some of whom are now grown and earning a living in the music world either as educators or performers.

A Far Cry

A Far Cry will appear at Colby Sawyer Center Theater in New London on Wednesday, August 25, at 7:30 PM.

Without a conductor, this superb group of 17 young and highly talented string players is getting rave reviews. This imaginative group of Boston artists has a repertoire that covers the musical spectrum, from Renaissance and Baroque to the 20th century.
