RGB Showing Rescheduled for March 6 at the Hub

An exceptional documentary about an icon

Due to the snow-caused cancellation of its February showing, the film RGB will be shown on Friday, March 6, at 2:30 PM instead, at the Andover Community Hub.

A documentary about the exceptional life, career, and enduring legal legacy of Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg, the film follows her journey from a girlhood in Brooklyn to her appointment to the highest court in the land. Along the way, Ginsburg has become an unexpected cultural icon known fondly as "the Notorious RBG."

One review said, "This riveting, surprisingly touching documentary reveals how the quiet, intense Ginsburg became one of the most iconic Supreme Court justices in American history."

The film was directed, written, edited, shot, and produced by women and premiered at the 2018 Sundance Film Festival. It was chosen by the National Board of Review as the Best Documentary Film of 2018 and earned Academy Award nominations for Best Documentary Feature and Best Original Song ("I'll Fight").
